Harold E. Munro

Harold "Hattie" E. Munro, 88, of 57 Buttercup Lane, McElhattan, died Aug. 2, 2006 at the Lock Haven Hospital ICU.

He was born in Queens Run, June 22, 1918 and was the son of the late William and Jennie Keiffer Munro.

Hattie was a 1938 graduate of the Lock Haven High School. He had served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II from 1944 to 1946.

Mr. Munro had worked for Piper Aircraft for 43 years, retiring in 1981 from the Flight Testing Department.

Hattie was a member of the Covenant United Methodist Church and had volunteered for the More Than Bread Program for more than 13 years. He had also volunteered at the Lock Haven Hospital for 14 years.

Survivors include his wife, Dorothy I. Burkett Munro, whom he married June 22, 1940; three daughters, Linda C. and her husband, Dennis Miller, of Shelbyville, Del., Sharon L. and her husband, David Masters, of Lock Haven and Deanna G. and her husband, Robert Barto, of Cape Coral, Fla.; 10 grandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by one daughter, Judith D. Kryder; a grandson, Sean E. Miller; a brother, Alfred (Scorchy) Munro; and a sister, Edith Mitchell.

Funeral services for Harold "Hattie" E. Munro will be held on Saturday, Aug. 5, 2006 at 11AM in the Yost-Gedon Funeral Home, 121 W. Main St., Lock Haven PA 17745.

Interment will be in the Rest Haven Memorial Park, Dunnstable Township, Clinton County, PA.
